PREFACE TO THE KOREN MEIR EINAYIM SIDDUR

"One generation will praise Your works to the next..."

It has been a dozen or so years since the introduction of the Koren range of Siddurim with English, under the auspices and direction of our rabbi and friend, Rabbi Lord Jonathan Sacks zt"l. During that time, it has become obvious that there is a large and growing need for the Siddur in a larger font, for users at both ends of the age spectrum. As useful for children learning to daven as it is for older people (like this writer!) such a Siddur is exceedingly valuable. We are pleased to present The Lobel Edition of the Koren Meir Einayim Siddur, which features larger fonts and an expansive layout.

In common with all our Siddurim and Maḥzorim, this Siddur presents several unique features:

- ► There are two distinct fonts, designed by Eliyahu Koren, used throughout the Siddur. The Koren Tanakh Font is used for Tanakh texts (except when embedded in prayers), and the Koren Siddur Font is used for prayers, in keeping with Mr. Koren's belief that the presentation of Tanakh text should be distinctive.
- ► The graphic layout distinguishes poetry from prose, and provides space to allow pages to "breathe." We have developed a parallel style for the English text that balances the weight of the Hebrew letters to further Mr. Koren's intention of presenting the texts "in a style that does not spur habit and hurry, but rather encourages the worshiper to engross his mind and heart in prayer."
- ► There are concise instructions throughout the text.

► There are prayers for visitors to Israel to reflect the essential and integral connection between the Jewish people in Israel and around the world, and the centrality of Jerusalem to us all.

It is always a privilege to collaborate on a project with those who share our commitment and enthusiasm for bringing out the beauty of *tefilla*. Mr. Lobel's eminently practical suggestions were particularly helpful during the conceptual process.
